## Curriculum

### Goldsmith Primary Academy will:

- Provide a high standard of education

- Encourage children to achieve their best in all subjects

### Parents/Carers will:

- Encourage children to take part fully in all school activities
- Support children's learning by attending parent consultations, assemblies and productions
- Provide the correct clothing and equipment for children to enable them to take part in all activities

## Equal Opportunities

### Goldsmith Primary Academy will:

## Welfare & Communication

### Goldsmith Primary Academy will:

### Parents/Carers will:

- Make sure that school always has up-to-date contact details

## Working At Home

### Goldsmith Primary Academy:

- May set a homework project once each term that will be linked to each topic
- Will send home reading books and change them regularly
- Will ensure that work done at home is celebrated in school

### Parents/Carers will:

- Read frequently with their children
- Support children in their home learning
- Help children to find a quiet place to do their reading/homework
- Ensure children look after school property when at home

## Attendance & Punctuality

### Goldsmith Primary Academy will:

- Contact parents/carers if there is a problem with attendance or lateness
- Maintain an accurate record of attendance
- Start classes promptly in line with each Keystage

### Parents/Carers will:

- Make sure children attend regularly and arrive on time
- Collect children on time at the end of the school day
- Contact school as soon as possible when children are absent
- Avoid holidays during term time
