<p><b>Traditional Tales</b> We will be listen to and discussing a wide range of stories and writing narratives about personal experiences. The children will be learning to use subordination – such as when/and/but/if/because.</p>	<p>This term we will be focussing on Multiplication and Division. The children will learn to recall and use multiplication facts for 2,5,10 times tables. Show that multiplication of two numbers can be done in any order but division can't. Use the <math>\times = \div</math> signs. Solve problems mentally and practically using multiplication and division facts.</p>	<p>In Science we will be investigating plants and growth. The children will ask simple questions and understand that answers can be different. We will be using equipment to observe change</p>
<p><b>Art</b></p> <p>We will be creating a class beanstalk. We will be recording observations using art materials, paint and other media. The children will learn to mix a range of colours and tones then match colours to objects. The children will learn to make and record long and short sounds using instruments. They will be encouraged to experiment with sound. The children will continue their weekly recorder lessons.</p>
