<p>The children will study Harry Potter and continue to read and discuss a wide range of fiction, poetry, plays, non-fiction and reference books and textbooks, increasing their familiarity with a wide range of books, including myths, legends and traditional stories, modern fiction, fiction from our literary heritage, and books from other cultures and traditions. They will produce a range of writing inspired by Harry Potter.</p>	<p>In Maths we will continue to deepen the children's understanding of fractions, decimals, percentages, and spotting patterns. We will also create opportunities for children to refine their calculation skills and algebraic proficiency as well as solving equations and inequalities and problem solving.</p>	<p>In Science the children will study light. They will recognise that light appears to travel in straight lines and use this idea to explain that objects are seen because they give out or reflect light into the eye and why shadows have the same shape as the objects that cast them. They will learn to explain that we see things because light travels from light sources to our eyes or from light sources to objects and then to our eyes.</p>
